A Declaration of Use can be filed if the marks are in use at that time for at least one service identified in the registrations and there is a specimen showing such use. Any service not offered with the marks when a Declaration of Use is filed must be deleted from the registrations.

After a Declaration of Use is accepted by the USPTO, the registrations will remain in force for the remainder of their 10-year term until the February 1, 2032 renewal date. Prior to that renewal date, applications must be filed to renew the registrations for the next 10 years, provided the marks are in use in commerce with at least one service in the registrations and there is a specimen showing such use at that time.

We recommend consistent use of the ® registration symbol when the marks are used in connection with the services identified in the registrations. The symbol provides notice to the public of the registered status of the marks.

Requirements in the First Ten Years*

What and When to File:

- **First Filing Deadline:** You must file a Declaration of Use (or Excusable Nonuse) between the 5th and 6th years after the registration date. See 15 U.S.C. §§1058, 1141k. If the declaration is accepted, the registration will continue in force for the remainder of the ten-year period, calculated from the registration date, unless cancelled by an order of the Commissioner for Trademarks or a federal court.
- **Second Filing Deadline:** You must file a Declaration of Use (or Excusable Nonuse) and an Application for Renewal between the 9th and 10th years after the registration date.* See 15 U.S.C. §1059.

Requirements in Successive Ten-Year Periods*

What and When to File:

- You must file a Declaration of Use (or Excusable Nonuse) and an Application for Renewal between every 9th and 10th-year period, calculated from the registration date.*

Grace Period Filings*

The above documents will be accepted as timely if filed within six months after the deadlines listed above with the payment of an additional fee.

***ATTENTION MADRID PROTOCOL REGISTRANTS:** The holder of an international registration with an extension of protection to the United States under the Madrid Protocol must timely file the Declarations of Use (or Excusable Nonuse) referenced above directly with the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO). The time periods for filing are based on the U.S. registration date (not the international registration date). The deadlines and grace periods for the Declarations of Use (or Excusable Nonuse) are identical to those for nationally issued registrations. See 15 U.S.C. §§1058, 1141k. 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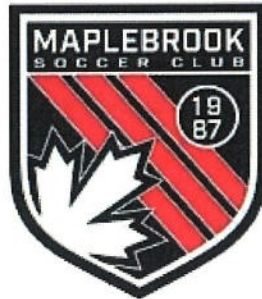
